

Key Healthcare Oversight Priorities 118th Congress

Based on public statements by current or would-be Committee chairs, below are our predictions for congressional oversight for next Congress.

• Public Health & COVID Response

- COVID-19 origins and federal funds supporting research done at Wuhan Institute of Virology
- o COVID-19 relief funding oversight waste, fraud and abuse
- CDC programs, funding, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including data gaps and pandemic-era guidance and requirements
- Nursing homes and facility responses to COVID-19 and beyond

• Health Care Affordability

- o Pharmacy Benefit Managers (PBMs) and their role in drug pricing
- Implementation of IRA (specifically Medicare's ability to negotiate for lower drug prices)
- Executive Order on Drug Pricing instructing CMMI to implement a new model focused on reducing drug prices
- o Site-neutral reimbursement in Medicare for services and prescription drugs
- Transparency into how much hospitals are charging, an effort which has been bipartisan; and continued expansion of price transparency efforts
- o Health care consolidation and market concentration

Other Biden Administration Initiatives

- ACA Family Glitch Rule
- Medicaid program integrity and unwinding process
- Substance use disorder response, including the increasing rate of deaths from fentanyl
- Section 1557 and nondiscrimination rules
- o Title X grants, abortion policy, and transgender care
- Baby Formula shortages and FDA's response
